### Performance Poetry

- To respond to a text as a critical reader (evaluating each part of the text to determine how good it is and what the message is).
- To recognise how a poet uses poetry as a voice to express feelings and views.
- To explore how poetry is presented on the page
- To interpret poems for performance.
- To gain and maintain the interest of the listener through effective performance of poems.
- To draft, compose and write poems based on personal interests, experiences and emotions.
- To use language and the features of poetic writing with intent for effect on the reader.
